## Learning to Follow Jesus: Christ Knew the Cost

Luke 22:1-23

This coming Sunday we will celebrate the risen, victorious Christ. Easter! But before then, as we move through Holy Week, we ponder the passion of Christ. We reflect on Christ's suffering and the sacrifice made on our behalf for our salvation. How costly the price that was paid! How deep the suffering! None of this was a surprise to Jesus. He knew the cost. And yet He willingly chose to go to the cross for us. How great a love!

4.	What was the significance of the Passover celebration in Jewish history?	
5.	How does Jesus transform what is remembered in Passover?

6.	Put yourself in the place of the disciples reclining at the table with Jesus. Think about the words that you are hearing Jesus say. What questions come to your mind? What are you thinking and feeling?

I would encourage you to reflect on and sit with what it truly means that Jesus was completely aware of what our salvation would cost him. His arrest, torture, and crucifixion were not the result of his other plans failing or being unable to find another way. This was the only way...and Jesus believed it to be worth it. This is the sort of realization that led to the authors of our Scriptures filling their pages with awe and praise. This is the sort of truth that has radically transformed lives for centuries. Everything Jesus did he did in willing obedience with the plan of God and in order to save...you. If you are already a believer and follower of Jesus, this week I want you to try to describe not what you think about this...but how this makes you feel. What happens in your heart and in your soul when you realize that Christ knew the cost of your forgiveness and your salvation, and did not hesitate to pay it in full?
